17. (Mineral Prospecting Permit Application No. 99, P.R.C.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the issuance of a joint mineral prospecting permit for 40 acres of land in Section 16, T. 11 S., R. 21 E., S.B.M., Imperial County to F. E. Hodges, P. O. Box 1666, Yuma, Arizona and to A. R. Contreras, 50 W. 3rd Street, Yuma, Arizona in accordance with the statutes and the rules and regulations.

18. (Mineral Lease No. 427.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming approval heretofore given by the Executive Officer of the assignment dated April 30, 1943 of the N¹/₂ of S¹/₂ of the SW¹/₄ and S¹/₂ of N¹/₂ of the SW¹/₄ of Section 36, T. 4 S., R. 5 E., M.D.M., containing 80 acres from the Humphreys Gold Corporation to Explorers Inc., said approval is given subject to the condition that Explorers Inc. will file with the Commission a \$5,000. bond guaranteeing performance under this mineral lease.

19. (Cormercial Lease No. 105, P.R.C.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted whereby approval was given to the issuance of a lease to Russel R. Travis covering one and one-fourth acres in the SW¹/₄ of NW⁴/₄ of Section 9, T. 1 N., R. 23 E., S.B.M., for a term of five years with an annual rental of \$36.50.

20. (Agreements for Purchase of State Land under Chapter 502, 1943.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, approval was given authorizing the Executive Officer to execute contracts with purchasers who have agreed to pay, on or before January 1, 1944, at least 20 per cent of the balance of the unpaid purchase price, and to make all subsequent payments of any deferred balance upon an amortized basis within the period of time specified within the extension agreements.

21. (Bid for Lease No. 60, P.R.C.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted instructing the Executive Officer to turn over to the Attorney General, for collection, the audited bill in the amount of \$2,660.01 now owed to the State by the Bishop Company of Orland, California.
