The lease shall recite that any minerals contained in the land shall remain the property of the State, and also that the rental is nominal and not indicative of the true value of the property.

29. (School Land Purchases Extension Agreements Under Chapter 502, Statutes of 1943) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted ordering the cancellation of the following extension agreements issued pursuant to Chapter 502 of 1943 and under which the purchasers have failed to pay the annual interest and principal payment due January 1, 1944.
