- 20. (Application of City of San Diego to Fill State Tide and Submerged Lands Mission Bay, San Diego County) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted approving the proposed development by the City of San Diego of certain tide and submerged lands in the southerly portion of Mission Bay in San Diego County. The Executive Officer was authorized to negotiate a lease of said lands with the City of San Diego.
- (Sale of Vacant School Land, Application No. 4534 Sacramento Land District) Paul Denny, in appearing before the Commission relative to his bid offer to purchase Section 36, T. 42 N., R. S W., M.D.M., Siskiyou County, presented an appraisal of Mr. David Nelson, State Forester, which indicated that this land had a maximum of 150,000 board feet of merchantable timber. San Bernardino County Mr. Clifford Hair) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the initiation of an exchange with the Federal Government for the  $SW_{4}^{1}$  of NE+ of Section 9, T. 5 N., R. 2 W., S.B.M., consisting of 40 acres in San Bernardino County. Upon completion of exchange, sale of this land to Mr. Clifford Hair at a price of \$5.00 per acre is authorized.
- 28. (Application to Purchase, SW of NE of Section 6, T. 9 S., R. 5 E., M.D.M. Santa Clara County) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the advertising for sale of the forty acre parcel described as the SW of NE of Section 6, T 9 S., R. 5 E., M.D.M., Santa Clara County. The advertisement shall stipulate that no offer of less than \$5.00 per acre will be accepted for the land and that each bidder shall deposit with the State a certified cashier's check in the amount of his bid.
