37. (Federal Exchange School Land Involving 12,442.6 acres - No. P.R.C. 125) The Commission was informed that the State was unsuccessful in its effort to lease with the United States Navy for 12,442.6 acres of vacant school land in Riverside and Imperial Counties, which were included in the "Declaration of Taling" filed by the United States Navy under Case No. 2054-Y Civil: but that the Federal Government would, however, agree to an exchange of this land with the Department of the Interior under the provisions of the Taylor Grazing Act. Upon notion duly made and ununimously carried, a resolution was therefore adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to exchange with the Department of the Interior, the following vacant school land:
