

5. (Capitan Field Area - Santa Barbara County) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Commission deferred action upon the recommendation that the State advertise for bids for a tide and submerged area in Santa Barbara County offshore from the upland Capitan Oil Field. It was brought to the Commission's attention that Shell Oil Company has recently completed a new deep upland well, and that a considerable area of the State's tide and submerged lands are subject to drainage. Lieutenant Governor Houser suggested that this Field be inspected by himself and the other Members of the Commission in the near future prior to proceeding with advertising call for bids.

6. (Cache Slough Area - Solano County) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to advertise for bids for a natural gas development lease of approximately 700 acres of slough land located in Solano County and known as Cache Slough. The Commission further approved, in this resolution, the recommendation that the lease be substantially the same type of lease as that presently in effect in the Rio Vista Gas Field.

7. (Standard Oil Company - Temporary Loading Ramp and Dolphins - Suisun Slough - No. P.R.C. 183) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the issuance of a temporary permit to Standard Oil Company of California for the location of a loading ramp and dolphins in Suisun Slough, the term of the permit to be ninety days, and subject to payment by applicant of filing fee of \$5.00, and further subject to the applicant's agreement to negotiate a lease for the use of the premises in the event applicant uses the area for a period in excess of ninety days or desires a permanent installation.

8. (Easement to Pacific Gas and Electric Company for 3½" Gas Line Crossing Under San Joaquin River at Stockton - No. P.R.C. 172) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the issuance of a fifteen year easement to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company for the location of 225 feet of 3½" gas line to be laid across the San Joaquin River to Rough and Ready Island, this easement to be issued in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Commission, the consideration for the easement to be an annual minimum rental of \$40.00, plus an additional two cents per each lineal foot of pipe installed on State land.

9. (Sale of Vacant School Land, Application No. 4540, Sonoma County - Sacramento Land District) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Commission authorized the sale of eighty acres of land in Sonoma County (S½ of SW¼ of Section 16, T. 9 N., R. 11 W., M.D.M.) to Anthony De Silva. Mr. De Silva's bid of \$400.00 was made pursuant to the Commission's recent advertising for bids for purchase of the area. This authorization was granted subject to inspection by the Executive Officer of the area in order to determine whether the land contains running water or mineral deposits.
