7. (Owens Lake Litigation) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted whereunder the Executive Officer was authorized to request the Attorney General to authorize Burdette J. Daniels, Special Deputy Attorney General to amend the State's complaint filed in their action against the City of Los Angeles to recover damage incurred by the State as a result of the Department of Water and Power's flooding of Owens Lake.

Mr. Daniels' preliminary estimate indicates the amount of the asserted damages to be in excess of \$1,000,000.00, on the basis of information and facts revealed by expert study of the matter.

8. A letter was reed from the State Controller, dated June 12, 1945, wherein he requested that the sum of \$350,000.00 should be transferred from the State Lands Act Fund to the General \*una, State Beach Fund and State Park Fund in the proportions of 30 percent, 23 1/3 percent and 46 2/3 percent, respectively.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the resolution was adopted approving this transfer.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
