

This approval is granted subject to any change which might result in necessary adjustment of the basic acreage figures to be agreed upon with respect to the 11th and 12th Revisions, and is further subject to the Standard Oil Company's agreeing to extend for a period of sixty days after the submission by the Standard Oil Company to the Commission of the revised map of the Rio Vista Field which the Standard Oil Company has agreed to submit, the time within which the State might make formal objection to the 11th to 55th Revisions, inclusive, of the State's percentage allotment.

9. (Notice of Default to Beloil Corporation, Ltd., et al., State Oil and Gas Leases Nos. P.R.C. 144 and 145, Rincon Point, Ventura County) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Executive Officer was authorized to withhold until February 1, 1946, any further action, pursuant to the default notice served upon Beloil Corporation, Ltd., et al. This Commission action was taken at the request of Fullerton Oil Company, a joint lessee under this lease, together with the remaining joint lessees. Fullerton Oil Company has agreed to comply with all of the drilling requirements under State Oil and Gas Leases Nos. P.R.C. 144 and 145, immediately upon completion and/or abandonment of a deep test to the "Second Deep Zone" as defined and prescribed in said lease.

10. (Application for Right of Way - Pacific Gas & Electric Company - No. P.R.C. 149) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the action of the Executive Officer in granting a fifteen year right of way to Pacific Gas and Electric Company for the construction and maintenance of a 10 3/4 inch gas pipe line 2460 feet in length and 100 feet in width under the Sacramento River at Rio Vista, and whereunder the State shall receive as annual rental \$89.20. The granting of this easement is subject to the inclusion of said easement under the \$50,000.00 blanket liability bond heretofore filed by grantee with the Commission.

11. (Application for Right of Way - Pacific Gas & Electric Company - No. P.R.C. 150) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the action of the Executive Officer in granting a fifteen year right of way to Pacific Gas and Electric Company for the construction and maintenance of a 12 3/4 inch gas line crossing 5668.6 feet in length and 100 feet in width under the San Joaquin River adjacent to the Antioch Bridge, and whereunder the State shall receive as annual rental \$124.61. The granting of this easement is subject to the inclusion of said easement under the \$50,000.00 blanket liability bond heretofore filed by grantee with the Commission.
