

18. (Owens Lake Litigation - People vs. City of Los Angeles - Deficiency Appropriation) Pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Commission at its March 16, 1946 meeting, Chairman Dean reported regarding the expenditures of the Attorney General in connection with the case of People of the State of California vs. City of Los Angeles (Owens Lake Litigation). Chairman Dean further requested that the Director of Finance be requested to approve a deficiency allotment to augment the support appropriation of the Division of State Lands.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Acting Executive Officer to request the Director of Finance to approve a deficiency allotment of \$30,000.00, and to execute a supplemental contract with the Department of Justice. This amount is to defray the expenditures of the Attorney General in the prosecution of this case.

19. A letter was read from the State Controller dated March 25, 1946, wherein he requested that the sum of \$350,000.00 be transferred from the State Lands Act Fund to the General Fund, State Beach Fund and State Park Fund in proportions of 30 per cent, 27 1/3 per cent and 46 2/3 per cent, respectively.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted approving this transfer.

There being no further business before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
