

26. (Grazing Lease Application No. P. R. C. 1163 - Siskiyou County - L. B. DeMoss) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Acting Executive Officer to execute and issue a 5 year grazing lease to L. B. DeMoss for Lots 1 and 2 (or $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$), Section 6, T. 46 N., R. 1 E., M. D. M., containing 78.48 acres in Siskiyou County. The annual rental is to be 25 cents per acre with the lessee to pay the first and last years' rental at the time of execution of the lease and the subsequent rentals annually in advance.

27. (Sale of Vacant School Land, Application No. 4549, Sacramento Land District - R. H. Conklin - Mono County) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the sale of the $E\frac{1}{2}$ and $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T. 9 N., R. 22 E., M. D. M., containing 400 acres in Mono County, to R. H. Conklin at a cash price of \$1,600.00. Mr. Conklin was the only bidder pursuant to the advertising. The land is to be sold subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.

28. (Administration - Transfer of Accounting Records) The Commission was informed that in accordance with recommendations previously given, the Director of Finance has approved the transfer of all accounting records relating to the Commission's business from the Department of Finance office in Sacramento to the Los Angeles office of the Commission subject to the approval of such transfer by the Commission.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted approving the transfer of all accounting records of the State Lands Commission to the principal office in Los Angeles, such transfer to be effected by September 30, 1946.

29. (Administration - Personnel Assignment) The Commission was informed that in order that operations of the Division of State Lands might proceed more effectively, it was desirable that an Acting Assistant Executive Officer be designated. Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted appointing Francis J. Hortig to the position of Acting Assistant Executive Officer.
