

26. (Sale of Vacant Federal Land Through Purchase of State Scrip to Walter Van Sands). Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted rescinding action of the Commission on August 22nd, 1946 in approving the sale to Walter Van Sands of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36, T. 6 S., R. 5 E., S. B. M., containing 80 acres in Riverside County, at a cash price of \$400.00, reserving all minerals to the State.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the sale to Walter Van Sands of the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36, T. 6 S., R. 5 E., S. B. M., containing 80 acres in Riverside County, embraced in his Application 10335, Los Angeles Land District, at a cash price of \$400.00, reserving all minerals to the State.

27. (Request for Transfer of Funds - State Controller) Request of the State Controller for authorizing of a transfer of \$500,000.00 in accordance with Section 6816 of the Public Resources Code from the accumulated balance of \$621,945.55 on September 27, 1946, was presented.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted granting the authorization for the transfer as requested.

28. (Sale of Vacant School Land Application No. 2129, Sacramento Land District - Mrs. Katheryne Baxter) Mrs. Katheryne Baxter appeared before the Commission to present her statement as to her claim of title to the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, T. 17 N., R. 16 E., M. D. M., containing 80 acres in Nevada County, through conveyance from M. N. Kimball, the original applicant, to William O'Neill, her father, the deed for which conveyance was unrecorded and destroyed by fire. It was further recorded that William O'Neill and his successors in interest have been in possession of the property and have paid the taxes thereon since 1898.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted in consideration of the color of title as evidenced by Mrs. Katheryne Baxter, authorizing the sale of the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, T. 17 N., R. 16 E., M.D.M., without advertising, to Mrs. Baxter at a cash price of \$400.00, subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.

29. (Tide and Submerged Lands - Proposed Discharge Pipe and Dolphins - Sacramento County Sanitation District No. 1 - No. P.R.C. 267) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the permission heretofore given to the County Sanitation District No. 1 of Sacramento to place and maintain a discharge pipe and dolphins on a right of way for a width of 100 feet and 100 feet long in tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River, Sacramento County, said permit to be issued to this public body at no cost, in accordance with law.
