

31. (Grazing Lease Application No. P.R.C. 1187, San Diego County - James C. Fuquay) The Commission was informed of the application received from Mr. James Fuquay of Pino Valley, for a grazing lease for a term of five years on the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, T. 17 S., R. 7 E., and  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, T. 18 S., R. 7 E., S.B.M., containing 160 acres in San Diego County, and subsequent advertising thereof.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to execute and issue a five year grazing lease to Mr. James Fuquay, the only bidder pursuant to advertising, at an annual rental of thirty-one cents per acre, with the lessee to pay the first and last years' rental at the time of execution of the lease.

32. (Silver Strand Area San Diego County - Condemnation Action No. 540-SD, Civil - W.O. No. 22) The Commission was informed that after consideration of the joint action by the State Park Commission and the State Lands Commission relative to condemnation actions brought by the Navy Department against State lands in the Silver Strand Area of San Diego County, the State Park Commission has requested by resolution that 138 acres of filled tide and submerged lands be transferred to it for recreational purposes by the State Lands Commission. Such transfer would be on the condition that if the area is acquired by the United States Government, any consideration paid for such acquisition would be transferred to the State Lands Commission.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the transfer of jurisdiction over the 138 acres of filled tide and submerged lands involved in condemnation Action No. 540-SD, Civil, to the State Park Commission, subject to the conditions that the lands be used for recreational purposes, and if acquired by the United States Government, that the consideration for the acquisition be paid into the State Lands Act Fund.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
