5. (APPLICATION FOR LEASE OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, MRS. L. IMOGENE VALLE, MIDDLE RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY - W.O. 586, P.R.C. 595) The Commission was informed that Mrs. L. Imogene Valle has applied for a lease of approximately one-half acre of tide and submerged land in Middle River, San Joaquin County, adjacent to the Borden Highway and the bridge crossing Middle River for use as a fishing resort. Staff appraisal indicates that the minimum annual rental of \$50.00 is required. A lease of the upland occupied by Mrs. Valle is in process of negotiation with the Drexler Estate, which estate owns a very large frontage along the river. Notice of trespass was sent Mrs. Valle on September 30, 1949.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO MRS. L. IMOGENE VALLE A YEAR BY YEAR LEASE OF APPROXIMATELY ONE-HALF ACRE OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN MIDDLE RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, ADJACENT TO THE BORDEN HIGHWAY AND BRIDGE AT AN ANNUAL RENTAL OF \$50.00, EFFECTIVE DATE OF LEASE TO BE SEPTEMBER 30, 1949, AND APPLICANT TO FURNISH PERFORMANCE BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000.00, AND UPON THE CONDITION THAT LEASE OF THE UPLAND BE OBTAINED BY MRS. 8. (GRAZING LEASE APPLICATION NO. P.R.C. 1211, INYO COUNTY - JOHN GRANT SAC. W.O. 5302) The Commission was informed that an application has been received from Mr. Grant of Los Angeles, California, for a grazing lease for a term of five years on all of the recession land lakeward of the U. S. meander line of Owens Lake in Section 6, T. 19 S., R. 37 E., M.D.M., containing 290 acres in Inyo County. The land has been advertised for lease and no other applications have been received. The applicant has offered twenty-five cents per acre per year which is the minimum of five per cent of the appraised value of the land, and is the minimum rental acceptable to the Commission.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE A FIVE YEAR GRAZING LEASE TO MR. GRANT AT AN ANNUAL RENTAL OF TWENTY-FIVE CENTS PER ACRE OF 290 ACRES LAKWARD OF THE OWENS LAKE MEANDER LINE IN SECTION 6, T. 19 S., R. 37 E., M.D.M., SUBJECT TO THE APPLICANT PAYING THE FIRST AND LAST YEARS' RENTAL AT THE TIME OF EXECUTION OF THE LEASE.

9. (PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY APPLICATION FOR RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT - GEORGIANA SLOUGH, SACRAMENTO COUNTY - W.O. 1020, P.R.C. 596) The Commission was informed that Pacific Gas and Electric Company has applied for a right of way easement 100 feet in width and 200 feet in length across Georgiana Slough in Sacramento County for the installation, maintenance and use of pipe lines transporting gas for a period of fifteen years with right of renewal for three additional periods of ten years each. Annual rental under the Commission policy is \$44.00.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, A RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT 100 FEET IN WIDTH AND 200 FEET IN LENGTH ACROSS GEORGIANA SLOUGH, SACRAMENTO COUNTY, FOR A PERIOD OF FIFTEEN YEARS AT AN ANNUAL RENTAL OF \$44.00, TOGETHER WITH THE RIGHT OF RENEWAL FOR THREE ADDITIONAL PERIODS OF TEN YEARS EACH AT SUCH TERMS AS MAY BE DETERMINED PRIOR TO EACH RENEWAL PERIOD FOR THE INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND USE OF PIPE LINES TRANSPORTING GAS, PERFORMANCE BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000.00 TO BE FURNISHED, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION THAT ALL PRODUCERS DELIVERING GAS TO THESE PIPE LINES UNDER THEIR DELIVERIES OF GAS UNDER THEIR PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY CONTRACT WILL BE (1) NOT IN EXCESS OF INDIVIDUAL WELL PRODUCTION RATES AS DETERMINED FROM THE RIO VISTA RATABLE TAKING PLAN OR (2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN EQUITABLE PRODUCING PLAN FOR THE TYLER ISLAND AREA SHOULD IT BE DETERMINED TO BE A SEPARATE PRODUCING UNIT OUTSIDE OF THE TECHNICALLY DESCRIBED RIO VISTA GAS FIELD.
