1. (ASMEXATION OF AREAS UNDER LEASE TO CALIFORNIA-HAWAIIAN SUGAR REFINING CORPORATION TO EAST BAY MUNICIPAL TTILITY DISTRICT - LEASES NOS. 9, 10, 11, AND 19, AND P.R.C. 220.) The California-Hawaiian Sugar Refining Corporation is a lesses of the State of California under the following leases:
