

4. (APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO OCCUPY SUBMERGED LAND AND TO CONSTRUCT PIER, LAKE TAHOE, EL DORADO COUNTY, BRUCE KELHAM - W.O. 1097, P.R.C. 639.) Bruce Kelham has applied for a permit to occupy submerged land and to construct a pier 197 feet long and 7 feet wide in Lake Tahoe, El Dorado County, south of Weeks Bay Post Office. A field survey is in process to locate the low-water line, the boundary between the State and the upland. Pending completion of this survey it has been concluded that issuance of a permit for a period of two years for the occupancy of submerged lands at an annual rental of \$10.00 is a practical solution of the problem of such applications. Filing fee and rental have been paid.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO BRUCE KELHAM A PERMIT TO OCCUPY SUBMERGED LAND IN LAKE TAHOE, EL DORADO COUNTY, AND TO CONSTRUCT A PIER 197 FEET IN LENGTH AND 7 FEET IN WIDTH, TERM OF PERMIT TO BE TWO YEARS AT AN ANNUAL RENTAL OF \$10.00, PAID IN ADVANCE, WITH PRIOR RIGHT TO THE ISSUANCE OF AN AGREEMENT FOR THE USE OF THE SAME AREA AT SUCH TERMS AS MAY BE DETERMINED AT THE END OF THE TWO-YEAR PERIOD.

5. (APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO OCCUPY SUBMERGED LAND AND TO CONSTRUCT PIER, LAKE TAHOE, PLACER COUNTY, THOMAS B. SILLS - W.O. 1086, P.R.C. 640.) Thomas B. Sills has applied for a permit to occupy submerged land and to construct a pier 72 feet long and 8 feet wide in Lake Tahoe, Placer County, southwest of Lake City. A field survey is in process to locate the low-water line, the boundary between the State and the upland. Pending completion of this survey it has been concluded that issuance of a permit for a period of two years for the occupancy of submerged lands at an annual rental of \$10.00 is a practical solution of the problem of such applications. Filing fee and rental have been paid.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO THOMAS B. SILLS A PERMIT TO OCCUPY SUBMERGED LAND IN LAKE TAHOE, PLACER COUNTY, AND TO CONSTRUCT A PIER 72 FEET IN LENGTH AND 8 FEET IN WIDTH, TERM OF PERMIT TO BE TWO YEARS AT AN ANNUAL RENTAL OF \$10.00, PAID IN ADVANCE, WITH PRIOR RIGHT TO THE ISSUANCE OF AN AGREEMENT FOR THE USE OF THE SAME AREA AT SUCH TERMS AS MAY BE DETERMINED AT THE END OF THE TWO-YEAR PERIOD.

6. (APPLICATION FOR LEASE, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, KLAMATH RIVER, DEL NORTE COUNTY, KLAMATH CEDAR COMPANY - W.O. 1104, P.R.C. 641.) Klamath Cedar Company has applied for a lease of approximately 1.0 acre of tide and submerged land in Klamath River about one mile downstream from Highway 101 bridge at Klamath, Del Norte County, for the purpose of constructing dolphins and driving piles for log storage. Area and value of the land applied for is such as to require the minimum \$50.00 annual rental. Filing fee and expense deposit have been paid.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO KLAMATH CEDAR COMPANY A LEASE COVERING APPROXIMATELY 1.0 ACRE OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN KLAMATH RIVER ABOUT ONE MILE DOWNSTREAM FROM THE HIGHWAY 101 BRIDGE AT KLAMATH, DEL NORTE COUNTY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING DOLPHINS AND DRIVING PILES FOR LOG STORAGE, PERIOD OF LEASE TO BE FIFTEEN YEARS AT AN ANNUAL RENTAL OF \$50.00, WITH RIGHT OF RENEWAL FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF TEN YEARS AT SUCH TERMS AS MAY BE DETERMINED PRIOR TO RENEWAL, PERFORMANCE BOND OF \$1,000.00 TO BE FURNISHED, SUBJECT TO ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT BY THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY.
