

27. (AUTHORITY AND DUTIES OF EXECUTIVE OFFICER - W.O. 1087.) At the meeting of the State Lands Commission on March 24, 1953, Minute Item No. 29, Pages 1782 to 1795, inclusive, there was presented to and approved by the Commission a codification of definitions of duties and of delegations of authority for the Executive Officer. At subsequent meetings of the State Lands Commission, additional delegations of authority were made by the Commission. It is possible that the Commission as now constituted might desire to review these delegations. Furthermore, experience has indicated that a few minor changes and additions appear to be advisable. It is therefore suggested that a new codification be presented to the Commission for action at a subsequent meeting.

The executive Officer is authorized to review previous delegations of authority to him, and to present to the Commission at a subsequent meeting his recommendations in the premises.
