UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, IT WAS RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED OPERAtions on certain tide and submerged lands in the pacific ocean at FINTA GORDA, VENTURA COUNTI, AND AT SANTA CRUZ ISLAND, SANTA BAR-BARA COUNTY, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE AND USE OF BREAK-WATERS. RAMPS AND FERRY SLIPS WITH NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THERETO. THE COMPRICEMENT OF OPERATION IS TO BE SUBJECT TO AN AGREEMENT TO exter into leases covering the lands to be occupied, at an annual RENTAL OF 6.6% OF THE APPRAISED VALUE OF THE LANDS USED, TILL MINI-MIM ANNUAL RENTAL BEING \$100 BACH. THE LEASES TO HE FOR A TERM OF 15 YEARS WITH RIGHT OF REMEMBL FOR TWO ADDITIONAL PERIODS OF TAN YEARS EACH UPON SUCH REASONABLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE STATE PRIOR TO REMEMAL. IT IS TO BE FURTHER PROVIDED THAT DETAILED ENGINEERING PLANS OF THE PROJECTS ARE TO BE APPROVED BY THE STATE AND THAT BONDS HE FURNISHED. ONE IN AN ANOUNT EQUAL TO ONE-HALF THE CONSTRUCTION COST OF THE PUNTA GORDA STRUC-TURBS TO CHARANTEE RESOVAL, AT LEASE TERMINATION, AND A SECOND BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 TO COVER ANY EROSION DANAGE, AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT WRITTIN WAIVERS OF NONOBJECTION, OR SUBLEASES FROM THE adjacent upland owners, and necessary expense deposits and filing FEES BE FURNISHED.

33. (LOCATION OF BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN ALPINE COUNTY AND AMADOR, CALAVERAS, AND TUOLUMNE COUNTIES - W.O. 710.) The Executive Officer presented the following Calendar Item:

"By resclutions dated June 16, 1950, July 21, 1950, and July 6, 1953, The Board of Supervisors of Alpine County petitioned the State Lands Commission to investigate and survey the problem of the location of the boundary between Alpine and Tuolumne Counties. The Commission's duty in such matters is covered in Government Code Sections 23170 to 23178, inclusive, and in Section 6204 of the Public Resources Code. In pursuance of these requests the Division of State Lands conducted investigations and submitted a preliminary report to the Commission which was considered at the meeting of June 30, 1952 (Item 29, pp. 1579-1581). The following action was then taken:

'UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, UPON DUE NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES AND THROUGH ADVERTISING, TO CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE MATTER OF THE LOCATION OF THE COMMON EQUIDARY LINE OF ALPINE AND TUOLIBME COUNTIES; THE PURPOSE OF THE HEARING BEING TO OBTAIN EXPRESSIONS OF VIEWS ON THE PRELIMINARY CONCLUSIONS AND SUCH ADDITIONAL INFORMATION BEARING UPON THE SUBJECT AS MAY BE FURNISHED. UPON COMPLETION OF THE HEARING, REPORT SHALL BE MADE TO THE COMMISSION FOR FINAL ACTION.'
