

4. (SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE, SAN DIEGO COUNTIES, RICHFIELD OIL CORPORATION - W.O. 2887, P.R.C. 1433.1.) Rich-
field Oil Corporation has made application for authorization to conduct sub-
marine geophysical exploration operations on those tide and submerged lands
under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission lying between the northerly
boundary of the County of Ventura and the California-Mexico Border. An operat-
ing permit has been requested for the period October 1, 1954 to December 31,
1954, inclusive. The Boards of Supervisors of the counties of Ventura, Los
Angeles, Orange and San Diego were informed that this application was to be
considered. The statutory filing fee has been paid by the applicant. 9/1

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, IT WAS RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE PERMITS, CONFORMING
TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION, TO THE
RICHFIELD OIL CORPORATION, FOR THE CONDUCT OF SUBMARINE GEO-
PHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS
UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION LYING OFF-
SHORE BETWEEN THE PROLONGATION SEAWARD OF THE NORTHERLY BOUNDARY
OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA AND THE PROLONGATION SEAWARD OF THE
CALIFORNIA-MEXICO BORDER, FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 1954 TO
DECEMBER 31, 1954, INCLUSIVE. THE PERMITTEE IS TO REIMBURSE THE
DIVISION OF STATE LANDS FOR ALL OF ITS INSPECTION COSTS. THE
PERMIT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE ONLY AS LONG AS A CONCURRENT PERMIT BY
THE FISH AND GAME COMMISSION IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SAME OPERATING
AREA.

5. (APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMITS,
LOS ANGELES, VENTURA, SANTA BARBARA AND SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTIES, STANDARD OIL
COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, P.R.C.s 962.1(A), 962.1(B), 962.1(C), 963.1(A), 963.1(B) -
W.O. 1873.) The Standard Oil Company of California has made application for
extension of the term of submarine geophysical exploration permits P.R.C.
962.1(A), 962.1(B), 962.1(C), 963.1(A) and 963.1(B), authorized for operation
in the offshore areas of Los Angeles, Ventura, Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo
Counties to permit initiation and completion of the exploration program for
which these permits were requested originally. The subject permits were author-
ized by the Commission for extension to September 10, 1954 on July 28, 1954.
The time extension requested currently is for the period terminating December 9,
1954, inclusive. The Boards of Supervisors of San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara,
Ventura and Los Angeles were informed that this application was to be considered. 9/1

JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE OFFSHORE AREA
LYING SOUTHERLY OF THE LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT ESTERO, SAN
LUIS OBISPO COUNTY AND NORTHERLY OF A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM
