

16. (CONSIDERATION OF SUBSIDENCE COSTS - L.B. W.O. 10,019.)

After presentation of Calendar Item 40 attached, upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION APPROVES THE COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" HEREOF, AND THE ESTIMATED EXPENDITURES IN THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 1957 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$77,000 TO COVER COSTS OF "FORCE ACCOUNTS AND VOUCHERS OTHER THAN CONSTRUCTION"; SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION, HOWEVER, THAT THE AMOUNT, IF ANY, OF EACH OF THE ITEMS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COST, DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 5(a) OF CHAPTER 29, STATUTES OF 1956, 1ST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IS COMPLETED; AND THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE MINERAL RESOURCES ENGINEER ARE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.

(CONSIDERATION OF SUBSIDENCE COSTS - L. B. W.O. 10,019)

On November 8, 1956 (Minute Item 13, pages 2283-85) the Commission approved the costs proposed to be expended by the City of Long Beach, including subsidence for remedial work during November, 1956 and estimated expenditures in the first portion of December, 1956 for payrolls and similar items.

The same elements of subsidence costs expenditures which are to be paid during December, 1956 accountable under subsidence costs not included in projects approved heretofore by the Commission will require approval by the Commission if credit is to be received by the City of Long Beach for such costs under the provisions of Section 5(a), Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956, 1st E.S. The staff of the State Lands Division has reviewed the statements presented by the City of Long Beach with respect to such expenditures during December, 1956. These amounts are tabulated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto. In addition, the Harbor Department has requested prior approval by the Commission of an amount of \$100,000 estimated to be expended during the month of January, 1957 for payroll force account and voucher payment other than by construction. The subsidence portion of this amount is estimated by the Harbor Department to be 77%, the same as estimated for November and December, 1956.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION APPROVE THE COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" HEREOF, AND THE ESTIMATED EXPENDITURES IN THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 1957 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$77,000 TO COVER COSTS OF "FORCE ACCOUNTS AND VOUCHERS OTHER THAN CONSTRUCTION"; SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION, HOWEVER, THAT THE AMOUNT, IF ANY, OF EACH OF THE ITEMS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COST, DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 5(a) OF CHAPTER 29, STATUTES OF 1956, 1ST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IS COMPLETED; AND THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE MINERAL RESOURCES ENGINEER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.
