## MINUTE ITEM

7. (SALE OF VACANT FEDERAL LAND, OBTAINED THROUGH USE OF BASE, LIEU LAND APPLICATIONS NOS. 4958, 5041, AND 5099, SACRAMENTO LAND DISTRICT, SANTA CLARA COUNTY, JAMES K. STONIER - S.W.O. NOS. 5666, 5833, AND 5965.)

After presentation of Calendar Item No. 19 attached, during which it was noted that the area indicated in the recommendation should be 586.49 acres instead of 585.35 acres, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXTENSIONS HERETOFORE GRANTED, UNTIL 5 P.M. MAY 13, 1957, WITHIN WHICH THE APPLICANT IS ALLOWED TO MEET THE APPRAISED VALUE OF THE LAND, EMBRACED IN APPLICATIONS NOS. 4958, 5041, AND 5099, ARE CONFIRMED.

Inspections and appraisals by a member of the Commission's staff on September 20 and on December 18, 1956, established the valuation on the land in accordance with the tabulation on page 1.

The applicant has objected to the values established, alleging they are above the market price for lands in that vicinity. For the purpose of allowing Mr. Stonier sufficient time to undertake an independent appraisal, an extension of 20 days was granted over and above the original period allowed by the Rules and Regulations of the State Lands Commission. It is understood that Mr. Stonier is desirous of appearing before the Commission, at the meeting to be held May 13, 1957, to protest the values established. He has also indicated that he has had the land revalued by an independent appraiser who

estab ishes the value of all the land at \$8 per acre.
