## 5.

(EXCHANGE OF LANDS BEIWHEN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND SCHUTZ CONGTRUCTION CO., MARIN COUNITY - W. 0. 394.)

Pursuant to Chapter 18, Statutes of 1952, as amended by Chppter 17, Statutes of 1957, the State Lands Commssion is authorized to grayt land held by the State of California in Marin County to any persons pezBons, or corporations, such grant to be conditioned upon the granting of eil might, title, and interest by such person: persons, or corporations to the State of California of parcels of land in Marin County. Lands to "e conveyed to the State shall be of equal or greatdar value then the lands conveyed by the State, determination of values to se made by the State Lerads Commssion, and in the event of a deficiency in value of lands couveyed, to the State, the State Lands Commission is authorized to accept cash in lieu of land, for the purpose of equalizing values. All of the lands to be conveyed to the state and by the State lie within the southeast quarter of Section 9; the southrest quarter of Section 10; the north half of Section 15; and the northesst quarter of Section 16, Township 1 North, Range 6 West, M.D.M.

The lands of the State are classified as tide and submergea iands, the aforesaid statute providing that upon completion of the exchange of lanus, the lands of the state will be no longer necessamy or usefui for navigation or fisheries. Chapter 17 of the Statutes of 1957 provides for the granting of mineral rights in the lands to be conyeyed by the state.

Lands of the State consist of portions of Corte Madera Canal. By agreement with Schuitz Construction Co. a new, shorter channel was to be constructed by Schultz under permit from the U. S. Axmy Corps of Fingineers, the new channel together with an area on each side thereof to be deeded to the State. The new channel has been constricted and completion approval given by the Corgs of Engineers.

Pursuant to Section 27281 of the Government Code it is mandatory that prior to recordation of a deed or griat the consent of the State Lands Conmission be evidenced by a Resolution of Acceptance attached to the deed, the same code section permitting an authorized officer or agent to execute such consent.

Pine State's lands have been appraised by an inderendent appraiser and found. to exceed the value of the lands to be recelved oy the State in the amount of $\$ 2,860.00$, which amount has been paid to the State by the Schultz Construction CO., a co-partnership. A deed covering the land to be conveyed to the State has been received ready for recordation, title report also having been received with letter from the Marin County Abstiract Company that that company would insure title to the State.
