THE ACTING EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO REVOKE ALL EXISTING GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMITS AS LISTED ON EXHIBIT "A" HERETO, AND TO ISSUE NEW PERMITS TO SUCH PERMITTEES, EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 15, 1957, FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION, IRRESPECTIVE OF THE DEPTH OF HOLE DRILLED FOR OBTAINING THE GEOLOGICAL SAMPLES.

(GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMITS - GEN. DATA - OIL AND GAS.)

Existing geological survey permits authorized by the State Lands Commission require that such permit be obtained for the drilling of any hole to a depth of greater than 500 feet below the ocean floor. Such permits are revocable at any time by the Commission.

Amendments to Title 2 of the Administrative Code, approved by the Commission October 8, 1957, will become effective November 14, 1957, providing that in conformance with Ch. 1087/57 geological survey permits will be required for the taking of cores and other samples on and under tide and submerged lands of the State irrespective of the depth of the hole.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE ACTING EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO REVOKE ALL EXISTING GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMITS AS LISTED ON EXHIBIT "A" HERETO, AND TO ISSUE NEW PERMITS TO SUCH PERMITTEES, EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 15, 1957, FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IRRESPECTIVE OF THE DEPTH OF HOLE DRILLED FOR OBTAINING THE GEOLOGICAL SAMPLES.
