An application has been received from the City and County of San Francisco for a life-of-structure permit on a portion of tide and submerged lands of San Mateo Canal, San Mateo County, for collecting sewers and diversion structure to serve the southeast portion of the City of San Francisco. As a portion of this site of about 8,000 square feet is covered by an easement to the State Division of Highways, their consent to the installation was obtained September 18, 1957. The Regional Water Pollution Control Board has also consented to the installation. No bond, filing fee or rents are required.
