An application has been received from the City of Los Angeles for a permit to construct a groin on tide and submerged lands of Santa Monica Bay, near the intersection of Sunset Boulevard and Pacific Coast Highway. The groin will occupy an area 40 feet in width and 170 feet in length, extending bayward from the line of high tide, and is to prevent coastal erosion. No fees or charges are to be made.
