After consideration of Calendar Item 35 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND SAN MATEO COUNTY HARBOR DISTRICT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF TWO BREAKWATERS ACROSS TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, BEING THE OUTER PERIMETER OF HALFMOON BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY, FOR THE CREATION AND PROTECTION OF HALFMOON BAY HARBOR. THE CONSIDERATION IS THE BENEFIT TO NAVIGATION.

(APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT BREAKWATERS, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF HALFMOON BAY, SAN MATEO COUNTY, U. S. CORPS OF ENGINEERS - W.O. 3128.)

pursuant to Section 6321 of the Public Resources Code, an application has been received for a permit to be issued jointly to the San Mateo County Harbor District and the United States of America for the construction and maintenance of two breakwaters to protect Halfmoon Bay in San Mateo County.

The construction of this facility will provide a protected harbor for boats of the fishing industry as well as for pleasure craft. The nearest protected harbors to this site are San Francisco Bay and Bodega Bay to the north and Monterey 90 miles to the south.

The Corps of Engineers has estimated that the project will cost in excess of \$4,000,000, which will be paid by the Harbor District and the United States. The breakwaters will be maintained by the United States.

The breakwaters will extend downcoast from Pillar Point and will occupy approximately 24.5 acres of tide and submerged lands. No fees or charges are required.
