31. APPROVAL OF THE MAPS OF THE SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY FROM NAPLES TO JALAMA - W.O. 2418, GEO.-SANTA BARBARA CO.

After consideration of Calendar Item 19 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE AND HAVE RECORDED SHEETS 1 THROUGH 39 OF THE MAPS ENTITLED "SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG THE SHORE OF THE PACIFIC OCEAN IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY", PREPARED UNDER WORK ORDER 2418 AS SURVEYED DURING THE PERIOD DECEMBER 1956 THROUGH JANUARY 1958.

APPROVAL OF THE MAPS OF THE SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY FROM NAPLES TO JALAMA - W.O. 2418.

Approximately 36 miles of ocean coastline were surveyed and mapped under Work Order 2418. The primary reason for the survey was to determine the position of the shoreward boundary of the adjoining offshore oil leases in Santa Barbara County. In addition to mapping the leased areas, the location of the Mean High Tide Line was established for future use in State boundary-line determinations.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE AND HAVE RECORDED SHEETS 1 THROUGH 39 OF THE MAPS ENTITLED "SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG THE SHORE OF THE PACIFIC OCEAN IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY", PREPARED UNDER WORK ORDER 2418 AS SURVEYED DURING THE PERIOD DECEMBER 1956 THROUGH JANUARY 1958.
