

MINUTE ITEM

5. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO PLACE CHANNEL MARKERS IN GALLINAS CREEK CHANNEL, SAN PABLO BAY, MARIN COUNTY, GALLINAS BOAT CLUB - W.O. 3182, P.R.C. 2389.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 16 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO GALLINAS BOAT CLUB TO INSTALL 36 CHANNEL MARKERS, SPACED 100 YARDS APART, FROM THE MOUTH OF GALLINAS CREEK ALONG AND IN SAN PABLO BAY TO A POINT APPROXIMATELY OPPOSITE AND NORTHERLY OF RAT ROCK IN MARIN COUNTY. THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE PERMIT IS THE BENEFIT TO NAVIGATION.

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO PLACE CHANNEL MARKERS IN GALLINAS CREEK CHANNEL, SAN PABLO BAY, MARIN COUNTY, GALLINAS BOAT CLUB - W.O. 3182.

The Gallinas Boat Club has applied for a permit, pursuant to Section 6504 of the Public Resources Code, to install 36 channel markers, 100 yards apart, to denote the channel from the mouth of Gallinas Creek through the shallow portion of San Pablo Bay to a point northerly of Rat Rock.

The U. S. Corps of Engineers concurs with the applicant that the installation will be a benefit to navigation.

The statutory filing fee has been paid.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO GALLINAS BOAT CLUB TO INSTALL 36 CHANNEL MARKERS, SPACED 100 YARDS APART, FROM THE MOUTH OF GALLINAS CREEK ALONG AND IN SAN PABLO BAY TO A POINT APPROXIMATELY OPPOSITE AND NORTHERLY OF RAT ROCK IN MARIN COUNTY, THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE PERMIT TO BE THE BENEFIT TO NAVIGATION.
