

MINUTE ITEM

11. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DEPOSIT SAND ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SEAL BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, CITY OF SEAL BEACH - W.O. 3193, P.R.C. 2395.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 37 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO THE CITY OF SEAL BEACH TO DEPOSIT APPROXIMATELY 225,000 CUBIC YARDS OF SAND ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SEAL BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN LYING BETWEEN THE WEST JETTY OF THE SEAL BEACH NAVAL AMMUNITION AND NET DEPOT, AND THE GROIN BEING CONSTRUCTED SEVEN FEET WEST OF THE WESTERLY LINE OF THE SEAL BEACH PIER UNDER PERMIT P.R.C. 2259.9; SAID PARCEL BEING FURTHER BOUNDED ON THE NORTHEAST BY THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK, AS SHOWN UPON THOSE CERTAIN MAPS "SURVEY OF THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK ON THE SHORE OF THE PACIFIC OCEAN IN SECTIONS 13, 14, AND 24, T. 5 S., R. 12 W., S.B.M.", PREPARED BY THE STATE LANDS DIVISION UNDER W.O. 416, AND BOUNDED ON THE SOUTHWEST BY A LINE PARALLEL AND DISTANT THEREFROM 1000 FEET FROM SAID ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE PERMIT IS THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DEPOSIT SAND ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SEAL BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, CITY OF SEAL BEACH - W.O. 3193.

An application has been received from the City of Seal Beach, pursuant to Section 6303 of the Public Resources Code, to deposit approximately 225,000 cubic yards of sand on the tide and submerged lands fronting the easterly portion of the City of Seal Beach, lying between the ordinary high water mark and a line seaward of, and 1,000 feet distant therefrom and parallel to the ordinary high water mark and bounded by the west jetty of the Naval Ammunition and Net Depot and the new groin being constructed under P.R.C. 2259.9. The proposed sand deposition is required to replenish the recreational beach and is a joint project of the applicant, U. S. Corps of Engineers and Water Resources Board. No fees or charges are required.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO THE CITY OF SEAL BEACH TO DEPOSIT APPROXIMATELY 225,000 CUBIC YARDS OF SAND ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SEAL BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN LYING BETWEEN THE WEST JETTY OF THE SEAL BEACH NAVAL AMMUNITION AND NET DEPOT, AND THE GROIN BEING CONSTRUCTED SEVEN FEET WEST OF THE WESTERLY LINE OF THE SEAL BEACH PIER UNDER PERMIT P.R.C. 2259.9; SAID PARCEL BEING FURTHER BOUNDED ON THE NORTHEAST BY THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK, AS SHOWN UPON THOSE CERTAIN MAPS "SURVEY OF THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK ON THE SHORE OF THE PACIFIC OCEAN IN SECTIONS 13, 14, AND 24, T. 5 S., R. 12 W., S.B.M.", PREPARED BY THE STATE LANDS DIVISION UNDER W.O. 416, AND BOUNDED ON THE SOUTHWEST BY A LINE PARALLEL AND DISTANT THEREFROM 1000 FEET FROM SAID ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK.
