Geological Survey Permit P.R.C. 2031.1 issued to the Union Oil Company of California, covering an area of tide and submerged lands in Santa Barbara, Ventura, Los Angles and Orange Counties, will expire May 15, 1959.

An application has been received from the Union Oil Company of California requesting an extension of the survey permit through November 15, 1959, in order to continue core drilling operations.
