37. SELECTION OF VACANT FEDERAL LAND, LIEU LAND APPLICATION NO. 10773-N, LOS ANGELES LAND DISTRICT, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, GEORGE MCCARTHY - S.W.O. 5804.

After consideration of Calendar Item 5 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION DETERMINES THAT IT IS TO THE ADVANTAGE OF THE STATE TO SELECT THE FEDERAL LAND EMBRACED IN THE $N\frac{1}{2}$, $N\frac{1}{2}$ OF $S\frac{1}{2}$ OF SECTION 33, T. 4 N., R. 4 E., S.B.M., CONTAINING 480 ACRES IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY; THE COMMISSION APPROVES THE SELECTION OF SAID LAND AND AUTHORIZES THE SALE THEREOF, PURSUANT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SALE OF VACANT STATE SCHOOL LAND, UPON THE LISTING (CONVEYANCE) OF SAID LAND TO THE STATE BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

SELECTION OF VACANT FEDERAL LAND, LIEU LAND APPLICATION NO. 10773-N, LOS ANGELES LAND DISTRICT, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, GEORGE MCCARTHY - S.W.O. 5804.

An offer was received from George McCarthy of Apple Valley, California, to purchase the $N\frac{1}{2}$, $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 33, T. 4 N., R. 4 E., S.B.M., containing 480 acres in San Bernardino County, at \$2,400. This land may be obtained by the State from the Federal Government under the indemnity selection procedure, and the State's application to select the land has been accepted by the Bureau of Land Management, subject to future approval and listing.

Mr. McCarthy has now decided that he does not desire to proceed with the acquisition of the land, and his application has been canceled at his request. However, the selection of the subject land is considered to be to the advantage of the State in that it will assist the State in satisfying the loss to the School Land Grant.
