42. APPROVAL OF THE MAPS OF THE SURVEY OF THE MEAN LOW WATER LINE AND ORDINARY LOW WATER MARK ALONG THE BANKS OF THE CARQUINEZ STRAIT AND MARE ISLAND STRAIT, SOLANO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - W.O. 1942-C, GEO.-SOLANO CO.

After consideration of Calendar Item 26 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

APPROVAL OF THE MAPS OF THE SURVEY OF THE MEAN LOW WATER LINE AND ORDINARY LOW WATER MARK ALONG THE BANKS OF THE CARQUINEZ STRAIT AND MARE ISLAND STRAIT, SOLANO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - W.O. 1942-C.

The area surveyed is covered almost entirely by tideland sales, pursuant to early statutes. Consequently, the waterward boundary of private ownership along the shore line is the line of mean low water.

There were approximately 40 privately owned structures extending waterward of the mean low water line at the time of the survey in 1955, and there are probably more at the present time. These maps will enable the State to determine the areas to be leased to owners of structures which occupy State submerged lands.
