

MINUTE ITEM

6. APPLICATION FOR SEWER OUTFALL EASEMENT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, MONTEREY BAY, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY, FREEDOM COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT - W.O. 3210, P.R.C. 2406.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 12 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A 49-YEAR EASEMENT TO THE FREEDOM COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT FOR A SEWER OUTFALL 10 FEET IN WIDTH AND 3,400 FEET IN LENGTH BAYWARD FROM THE LINE OF MEAN HIGH TIDE IN MONTEREY BAY, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY, THE CENTERLINE OF SAID STRIP BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF MONTEREY BAY, WHICH BEARS S. 72° 00' W., 510 FEET MORE OR LESS AND S. 28° 02' E., 121.9 FEET FROM U.S.C. & G.S. TRIANGULATION STATION "PAJARO MOUTH 3" AS SHOWN UPON THE MAP "RECORD OF SURVEY MADE FOR CITY OF WATSONVILLE" WHICH IS RECORDED IN VOLUME 29, PAGE 56 OF MAPS, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY RECORDS; THENCE FROM THE POINT OF BEGINNING S. 72° W., 3,400 FEET, CONTAINING 0.78 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR SEWER OUTFALL EASEMENT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, MONTEREY BAY, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY, FREEDOM COUNTY SANITARY DISTRICT - W.O. 3210.

An application has been received from Freedom County Sanitation District, pursuant to Section 6502 of the Public Resources Code, for an easement 10 feet in width and 3,400 feet in length to contain a sewer outfall line in tide and submerged lands of Monterey Bay near the mouth of the Pajaro River, Santa Cruz County. The Regional Water Pollution Control Board stated their approval of this project by letter dated April 21, 1959. No fees or charges are to be made.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A 49-YEAR EASEMENT TO THE FREEDOM COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT FOR A SEWER OUTFALL 10 FEET IN WIDTH AND 3,400 FEET IN LENGTH BAYWARD FROM THE LINE OF MEAN HIGH TIDE IN MONTEREY BAY, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY, THE CENTERLINE OF SAID STRIP BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
