An offer has been received from George C. Hanschild of Oxnard Air Force Base, California, to purchase the <u>NEL</u> of Section 36, T. 2 N., R. 14 E., S.B.M., containing 160 acres in San Bernardino County, at \$2 per acre.

A staff appraisal shows that the land is not suitable for cultivation without artificial irrigation, and establishes its value at \$7.50 per acre, or a total of \$1,200. The applicant deposited the necessary amount to meet this value.

The land was advertised for sale with a stipulation that bids must be in excess of \$1,200. No bids were received pursuant to advertising.
