6. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO PLACE MARKING BUOYS UPON SUBMERGED LANDS OF LAKE TAHOE FOR D. L. BLISS STATE PARK, EL DORADO COUNTY, DIVISION OF BEACHES AND PARKS - W.O. 3239, P.R.C. 2414.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 23 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT FOR 10 YEARS TO THE DIVISION OF BEACHES AND PARKS TO INSTALL AND MAINTAIN 14 DRUM BUOYS IN LAKE TAHOE, OFFSHORE FROM D. L. BLISS STATE PARK, IN EL DORADO COUNTY, TO DENOTE A "NO BOATING" ZONE, THE CONSIDERATION BEING THE PUBLIC INTEREST.

An application has been received from the Division of Beaches and Parks, pursuant to Section 6502 of the Public Resources Code, for a permit to install and maintain 14 drum buoys in Lake Tahoe, offshore from D. L. Bliss State Park, in El Dorado County, to denote a "no boating" zone in the Lester Beach and Callawee Cove area. No fees or charges are required.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT FOR 10 YEARS TO THE DIVISION OF BEACHES AND PARKS TO INSTALL AND MAINTAIN 14 DRUM BUOYS IN LAKE TAHOE, OFFSHORE FROM D. L. BLISS STATE PARK, IN EL DORADO COUNTY, TO DENOTE A "NO BOATING" ZONE, THE CONSIDERATION BEING THE PUBLIC INTEREST.
