17. APPLICATION FOR EASEMENT FOR SEWER LINE CROSSING TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF STOCKTON CHANNEL IN STOCKTON, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, CITY OF STOCKTON -W.O. 3266, P.R.C. 2433.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 16 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A 49-YEAR EASEMENT TO THE CITY OF STOCKTON FOR A SEWER LINE CLOSSING TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF STOCKTON CHANNEL, 16 FEET IN WIDTH AND APPROXIMATELY 437 FEET IN LENGTH, SAID STRIP BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF LAND 16 FEET IN WIGTH SITUATE IN THE STOCKTON CHANNEL AND LYING 8 FEET ON EITHER GIDE OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED CENTER-LINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE ORD ARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE RIGHT BANK OF THE STOCKTON CHANNEL W ICH BEARS S. 7° 30' E., 40 FEET FROM THE MOST SOUTHERLY CORNY & COMMON TO LOTS 16 AND 17 IN BLOCK 14 OF TERMINAL TRACT, AS SAID LOTS AND BLOCKS ARE SHOWN UPON "MAP OF TERMINAL TRACT, CTOCKTON, SAN JOAQUIN CO., CALIFORNIA", FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER OF SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY ON SEPTEMBER 13, 1895, IN BOOK OF MAPS AND PLATS IN VOLUME 2, PAGE 64; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING S. 7° 30' E., 437 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER LINE OF THE LEFT BANK OF THE STOCKTON CHANNEL, CONTAINING .16 ACRE.

An application has been received from the City of Stockton, pursuant to Section 6502 of the Public Resources Code, for an easement 16 feet in width and approximately 437 feet in length to contain a sewer line crossing Stockton Channel, the centerline of which easement extends South 7° 30' E. from the lot line between Lots 16 and 17, Blk. 14, Terminal Tract, in the City of Stockton.
