APPLICATION FOR SUBMARINE PIFE LINE EASEMENT OVER TIDE AND SUPMERGED LANDS, PACIFIC OCEAN NEAR CARPINIRRIA, SANIA BARBARA COUNIY, STANDAKD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W.O. 3150.

On March 25, 1959 (Minute Item 16, page 4647), the Commssion authorized the issuance to Standard Oil Company of California of a 49-year pipe line easemeni, 100 feet in width, extending 1ato the Facific Ocean 2, 750 feet from a point on the mean high tide line near Carpinteria in Sante Rarbara County.

It was subsequently discovered that the authorized easement lies within the area granted in trust to the County of Santa Barbara by Chapter 846, Statutes of 1931. Therefore, the anthorized easement was not executed. It was figrther noted that snother essemeni, P.R.C. 469.1 , issued to Standard Oil Company of California od September 15 , 1949 its also located in the ifrea granted to Santa Barbara County. The lease was granted for a 15 -year term at a total rental of $\$ 1,352.10$, with the first and last years' rental paid in advance, and provided for annual payments thereafter of $\$ 90.14$. County officials have been apprised of these facts and are taking action to issue County authorization for the facilities.

As/a substitute for the two previously authorized easements, the Standard oil Company of California has applied for a 49 -year lease of any reversionary interest of the State in the same easement areas for the construction; maintenance and use of submarine pipe lines, at a total rentel of \$200, payable in advance.

To clear the record, Ielase P.R.C. 469.1 should be ter dinated and the Commibsion action of Narck 25, 1959, under Minute Item 16 houla be rescinded.

The appilication expense deposit and the statutory filing fee have been paid. The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers hes issued perinits for these Instaliations.

The Standard Oil Company of Callfornia has agreed to forego any ciaim for rentals collected by the State for Lease P.R.C. 469.1 .
