

MINUTE ITEM

4. APPLICATION FOR EASEMENT OVER STATE SOVEREIGN LANDS IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN REQUIRED FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR AND PROTECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE VII-LA-60-LA, LOS ANGELES COUNTY, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS - W.O. 2911, P.R.C. 2462.9.

Following presentation of Calendar Item 6 attached, the Executive Officer called the attention of the Commission to the fact that a similar easement had been granted heretofore on a temporary basis, and at that time a protest had been made by the State Division of Beaches and Parks. The current request has been reviewed with that Division, which reported that it had no objection to issuance of the permanent easement.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 101.5 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE AND SECTION 6210.3 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, FOR A RIGHT-OF-WAY OVER STATE SOVEREIGN LANDS LYING BETWEEN STATIONS 310+00 AND 356+00, AS SHOWN ON THE MAP DATED JULY 30, 1958, TO BE USED IN THE CONSTRUCTION AND PROTECTION OF HIGHWAY NO. VII-LA-60-LA.

APPLICATION FOR EASEMENT OVER STATE SOVEREIGN LANDS IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN
REQUIRED FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR AND PROTECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE
VII-LA-60-LA, LOS ANGELES COUNTY, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS - W.O. 2911.

An application has been received from the Division of Highways, pursuant to Section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code, for an easement extending waterward approximately 600 feet from the mean high tide line of the Pacific Ocean and lying between Station 310+00 and Station 356+00, needed as a right-of-way for the construction and protection of the relocated highway as shown on State Highway Map VII-LA-60-LA, which shows the relocation made necessary by extensive landslides upcoast from Santa Monica Beach in the City of Los Angeles.

Since this easement site is adjacent to Will Rogers State Beach Park, the Division of Beaches and Parks was informed of the application. That Division has reported that there are no objections to the issuance of the easement.
