

MINUTE ITEM

24. APPLICATION FOR MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE, TUOLUMNE RIVER, STANISLAUS COUNTY, M. J. RUDDY & SON - W.O. 3258.

After consideration of Calendar Item 28 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO OFFER FOR LEASE, PURSUANT TO COMPETITIVE PUBLIC BIDDING, FOR THE EXTRACTION OF SAND AND GRAVEL AT A MINIMUM ROYALTY OF SIX CENTS PER CUBIC YARD FOR ALL SAND AND GRAVEL EXTRACTED, THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED AREA OF SUBMERGED LANDS:

THE BED OF THE TUOLUMNE RIVER LYING BETWEEN THE LINES OF LOW WATER LOCATED IN THE NW $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 5, T. 4 S., R. 11 E., M.D.B. & M., STANISLAUS COUNTY, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 18 ACRES.

APPLICATION FOR MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE, TUOLUMNE RIVER, STANISLAUS COUNTY,

An application has been received from M. J. Ruddy & Son requesting that an area of approximately 18 acres of the bed of the Tuolumne River in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, T. 4 S., R. 11 E., M.D.B. & M., Stanislaus County, be offered for lease for sand and gravel extraction, pursuant to competitive public bidding, in accordance with the provisions of Division 6 of the Public Resources Code.

The Corps of Engineers have stated that they have no jurisdiction in the area of the proposed operations. The applicant has entered into a lease with the south bank upland owner providing for the extraction of sand and gravel. The statutory filing fee has been paid and the required expense deposit has been made.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO OFFER FOR LEASE, PURSUANT TO COMPETITIVE PUBLIC BIDDING, FOR THE EXTRACTION OF SAND AND GRAVEL AT A MINIMUM ROYALTY OF SIX CENTS PER CUBIC YARD FOR ALL SAND AND GRAVEL EXTRACTED, THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED AREA OF SUBMERGED LANDS:
