After consideration of Calendar Item 33 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE SHELL OIL COMPANY A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT IN THE FORM AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION ON JULY 30, 1959, FOR THE PERIOD MAY 1, 1960 TO APRIL 30, 1961, INCLUSIVE, AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE WESTERLY EXTENSION OF THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, LAZA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES, SHELL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 3533.

An application has been received from the Shell Oil Company for a geological survey permit, conforming with the modified form of permit for geological surveys authorized by the State Lands Commission on July 30, 1959, providing for the conduct of core-drilling operations on those tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission in Santa Barbara, Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego counties, for the period May 1, 1960 to April 30, 1961, inclusive. The statutory \$5 filing fee has been paid by the applicant.
