An offer has been received from the State of California, State Park Commission, to purchase Lot 1 of fractional Section 36, T. 10 N., R. 1 W., H.M., containing 3.10 acres in Humboldt County. The applicant made an offer of \$6.20, or \$2 per acre, the minimum amount required by law.

The above-described land adjoins Dry Lagoon Beach State Park and is within the area proposed for addition to the park.

A staff appraisal shows that the land is not suitable for cultivation without artificial irrigation and establishes its value at an average of \$650 per acre, or a total of \$2,015.
