Following presentation of Calendar Item 24 attached, the Executive Officer outlined the specific full-time assignment of a Survey Crew of the State Lands Division to determine boundaries of State-owned water areas adjacent to privately owned uplands, and explained that the Crew has a tremendous backlog of work.

In response to a question by the Chairman, the Executive Officer stated that the adjoining upland owners knew of this specific survey, and, although they may not necessarily agree with it, there could not be any effective court contest until the survey had been filed for record.
