

MINUTE ITEM

18. APPROVAL OF MAPS.

In presenting Calendar Items 3, 4 and 19 attached, the Executive Officer explained to the Commission that the State Lands Division survey crew was presently spending the major portion of its time on survey problems in connection with defining State boundaries in areas where artificial influences may result from construction of protective facilities, and in areas where legislative requirements make it necessary to define boundaries in granted areas.

- (A) APPROVAL OF MAPS OF THE SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG THE SHORE OF SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL FROM SUMMERLAND TO COAL OIL POINT, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY - W.O. 2740, GEO.-SANTA BARBARA CO.

APPROVAL OF MAPS OF THE SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG THE SHORE OF SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL FROM SUMMERLAND TO COAL OIL POINT, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY - W.O. 2740.

A survey has been made along the coast of Santa Barbara County to complete a series of coastal surveys: from Point Conception to a point about eight miles south of the Ventura River in Ventura County. This gives the State Lands Division a continuous survey of the mean high tide line for use in describing oil leases or for historical reference in the event of artificial changes in the coast line.

APPROVAL OF MAPS OF THE SURVEY OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ALONG THE SHORE OF MONTEREY BAY, VICINITY OF SANTA CRUZ, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - W.O.3078.

A survey has been made of the Mean High Tide Line along the shore of Monterey Bay to establish the location of the last natural mean high tide line prior to construction by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers of jetties and other shore-protection facilities.

APPROVAL OF MAPS OF THE GRANT TO THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, VICINITY OF SAN DIEGO BAY, SAN DIEGO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - W.O. 3277.

Chapter 706 of the Statutes of 1959 conveyed certain tidelands in the Bay of San Diego to the City of Chula Vista and further directed the State Lands Commission, at the cost of the grantee, to survey, monument, plat and record in the office of the County Recorder the maps of the area conveyed.

The required survey and maps have been completed by the State Lands Division in accordance with the service agreement between the State of California and the City of Chula Vista.
