4. APPLICATION FOR SEWER OUTFALL EASEMENT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF PACIFIC OCEAN ADJOINING CITY OF PACIFICA (SAN PEDRO PLANT), SAN MATEO COUNTY, CITY OF PACIFICA - W.O. 3679, P.R.C. 2632.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 10 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF PACIFICA A 49-YEAR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT FOR A SEWER OUTFALL LINE ACROSS TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN MATEO COUNTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND, IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF PACIFICA, SAN MATEO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SAID STRIP OF LAND BEING FIFTEEN (15) FEET IN WIDTH AND LYING SEVEN AND ONE-HALF (7.5) FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTER-LINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE, DISTANT THEREON N. 67° 50' W., 999.50 FEET FROM AN EXISTING IRON PIPE MONUMENT SET IN HANDHOLE IN THE CENTERLINE OF LINDA MAR BOULEVARD, SAID MONUMENT BEING S. 50° 29' 26" E., 434.44 FEET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF LINDA MAR BOULEVARD AND STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 56, AS SAID MONUMENT, BOULEVARD AND HIGHWAY ARE SHOWN UPON THAT CERTAIN MAP ENTITLED "TRACT NO. 681, LINDA MAR NO. 7, SAN MATEO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA" WHICH MAP WAS FILED FOR RECORD ON DECEMBER 16, 1953, IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, IN VOLUME 38 OF MAPS AT PAGE 5; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING N. 20° 13' W., A DISTANCE OF 1970.0 FEET TO THE END OF SAID CENTERLINE, CONTAINING O. 678 ACRE, MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR ISSUANCE OF THE EASEMENT IS THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR SEWER OUTFALL EASEMENT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF PACIFIC OCEAN ADJOINING CITY OF PACIFICA (SAN PEDRO PLANT), SAN MATEO COUNTY, CITY OF PACIFICA - W.O. 3679.

An application has been received from the City of Pacifica for a right-of-way easement for a sewer outfall line 15 feet in width and 1,970 feet in length, containing 0.678 acre, more or less, extending into the Pacific Ocean from the mean high tide line, to serve the City's San Pedro area. Connecting easements across the uplant to the treatment plant have been obtained. The U.S. Public Health Service is furnishing a construction grant for this project.

No fees or charges are required.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF PACIFICA A 49-YEAR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT FOR A SEWER OUTFALL LINE ACROSS TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN MATEO COUNTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND, IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF PACIFICA, SAN MATEO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SAID STRIP OF LAND BEING FIFTEEN (15) FEET IN WIDTH AND LYING SEVEN AND ONE-HALF (7.5) FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE POLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTER-LINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE, DISTANT THEREON N. 67° 50' W., 999.50 FEET FROM AN EXISTING IFON PIPE MONUMENT SET IN HANDHOLE IN THE CENTERLINE OF LINDA MAR BOULEVARD, AID MONUMENT BEING S. 50° 26" E., 434.44 FEET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF LINDA MAR BOULEVARD AND STATE HIGHWAY. THE 56, AS SAID MONUMENT, BOULEVARD AND HIGHWAY ARE SHOWN UPON THAT CERTAIN MAP ENTITIED "TRACT NO. 681, LINDA MAR NO. 7, SAN MATEO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA" WHICH MAP WAS FILED FOR RECORD ON DECEMBER 16, 1953, IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, IN VOLUME 38 OF MAPS AT PAGE 5; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING N. 20° 13' W., A DISTANCE OF 1970.0 FEET TO THE END OF SAID CENTERLINE, CONTAINING O.678 ACRE, MORE OR LESS.
