

MINUTE ITEM

16. APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, SANTA BARBARA, SAN LUIS OBISPO, MONTEREY, SANTA CRUZ, SAN MATEO, SAN FRANCISCO, MARIN, SONOMA, MENDOCINO, HUMBOLDT AND DEL NORTE COUNTIES, SHELL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 3707, P.R.C. 2641.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 42 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE SHELL OIL COMPANY A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, IN THE FORM AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION ON JULY 30, 1959, FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 1960 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 1961, INCLUSIVE, AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

An application has been received from the Shell Oil Company for a geological survey permit for the conduct of core-drilling operations on the tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission in Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo, Monterey, Santa Cruz, San Mateo, San Francisco, Marin, Sonoma, Mendocino, Humboldt and Del Norte Counties for the period October 1, 1960 to September 30, 1961, inclusive.

The statutory \$5 filing fee has been paid by the applicant.
