SAIE OF VACANT SCHCOL LAND, APPLICATION NO. 11640, IOS ANGELES IAND DISTRICT, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY FIOOD CONTROL DISTRICT - S.W.O. 7590.

The Comission, by resolution adopted at its meeting held May 24,1960 (Minute Item 27, pages 6014-6017), witharew the hereinafter described land from sale pending the filing of a proper application by the San Bernardino County Flood Control District.

In accordance with the aforesaid action, an application to purchase was filed by the San Bernardino County Flood Control District, San Bernardino, California, on June 15, 1960, accompanied by a cash offer of $\$ 4,871$, for that poxtion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T. 1 N., R. 8 E., S.B.M., more particularly described hereinafter and containing 131.84 acres, more or less. This land is desired by the district as a part of the "thentynine Palms Flood Channel" system, which will serve the area by protecting it from flood hazards.

Inasmuch as the lends under discussion are subject to "flash" floods, and in authorizing withdrawal it was the intent of the Commission to hold them for sale to the Flood Control District, they were not made subject to the "Review by State Agencies" procedure currentiy in force.

A staff appreisal shows that the land is not suitable for cultivation without artificial irrigation and establishes its value at an average of $\$ 60$ per acre, or a total of $\$ 7,910.40$. The applicant deposited the necessary eqmount to meet this value.
