

MINUTE ITEM

7. APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES AND ORANGE COUNTIES, PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY - W.O. 3919, P.R.C. 2717.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 10 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, IN THE FORM AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION ON JULY 30, 1959, FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 12, 1961, TO OCTOBER 12, 1961, INCLUSIVE, AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT ARGUELLO, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE EXTENSION SEAWARD OF THE NORTHERLY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY.

APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES AND ORANGE COUNTIES, PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY - W.O. 3919.

An application has been received from the Phillips Petroleum Company for a geological survey permit for the conduct of core-drilling operations on tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission in Santa Barbara, Ventura, Los Angeles and Orange counties for the period April 12, 1961, to April 11, 1962, inclusive.

The statutory \$5 filing fee has been paid by the applicant.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO THE PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, IN THE FORM AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION ON JULY 30, 1959, FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 12, 1961, TO OCTOBER 12, 1961, INCLUSIVE, AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT ARGUELLO, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE EXTENSION SEAWARD OF THE NORTHERLY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY.
