STATUS OF LEGISLATION - 1961 SESSION - W.O. 3300.2.

On December 22, 1960 (Minute Item 32, page 6589), the Commission authorized the introduction of six legislative bills for the purpose of clarifying sections of the Public Resources Code. These bills were introduced by Senator Stanley Arnold as Senate Bills 237 through 242 inclusive.

Senate Bill 240 proposed to establish relative time of receipt as the order of priority for consideration of purchase applications filed by any county, city, district, political subdivision, agency, or officer of the State. This bill was amended in committee to limit relative priorities to applications from a county, city, or officer of the State.

Senate Bill 242 was also amended in committee to include current fund nomenclature as requested by the Controller.

All bills have been passed by the Senate, and have been referred to the Assembly Committee on Natural Resources, Planning and Public Works.

The staff are also following the progress of seventeen Senate bills and eighteen Assembly bills which would have a definite effect on the laws governing the Commission's operations, and of six Senate bills and six Assembly bills which may have an incidental or corollary effect on the Commission's operations.
