

MINUTE ITEM

3. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DREDGE IN CARQUINEZ STRAIT, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, AMERICAN SMELTING AND REFINING COMPANY - W.O. 4100, P.R.C. 2797.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 4 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO AMERICAN SMELTING AND REFINING COMPANY A PERMIT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 7,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF THE STATE IN CARQUINEZ STRAIT, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, ADJACENT TO APPLICANT'S WHARF, AND TO DEPOSIT THE DREDGED MATERIAL IN DEEP WATER OF THE STRAIT, THE CONSIDERATION FOR ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT TO BE THE BENEFIT TO NAVIGATION.

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DREDGE IN CARQUINEZ STRAIT, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, AMERICAN SMELTING AND REFINING COMPANY - W.O. 4100.

An application has been received from American Smelting and Refining Company for a permit to dredge approximately 7,000 cubic yards of material from tide and submerged lands of the State in Carquinez Strait adjacent to the applicant's wharf at Selby (the wharf location is authorized by Lease P.R.C. 618.1). The dredged material is to be deposited in deep water in Carquinez Strait, as authorized by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers. To provide sufficient depth of water at the Selby wharf to accommodate ocean-going vessels, similar permits were previously authorized in 1954, 1956, 1957, and 1958.

Consideration for issuance of the permit is to be the benefit to navigation. The filing fee has been paid.
