

MINUTE ITEM

7. APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF EXTENSION OF RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMITS TO CONDUCT EXPLORATORY WORK, SURVEY AND CONSTRUCT AN UNDERGROUND COMMUNICATION CABLE TO CROSS THE FEATHER RIVER, SUTTER AND YUBA COUNTIES, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA - W.O. 4121.

After consideration of Calendar Item 7 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMITS P.R.C. 2635.9 AND P.R.C. 2655.9 PROVIDING FOR THEIR EXTENSION TO SEPTEMBER 30, 1962. THE CONSIDERATION IS THE INTEREST OF NATIONAL DEFENSE.

APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF EXTENSION OF RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMITS TO CONDUCT EXPLORATORY WORK, SURVEY AND CONSTRUCT AN UNDERGROUND COMMUNICATION CABLE TO CROSS THE FEATHER RIVER, SUTTER AND YUBA COUNTIES, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA - W.O. 4121.

Right-of-Entry Permits P.R.C. 2636.9 and P.R.C. 2655.9 were issued to the United States of America, effective September 29, 1960, granting:

1. For a term of eight months, the right to conduct exploratory work and to survey the route of a proposed underground communication cable.
2. For a term of twelve months, the right to install the underground cable along the centerline of a strip of land 35 feet in width, crossing under the Feather River in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T. 12 N., R. 3 E., M.D.M., in Sutter County, and in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T. 16 N., R. 3 E., M.D.M., in Sutter and Yuba Counties.

The United States Army Corps of Engineers has requested that both permits be extended to September 30, 1962, to provide time to solve technical problems in connection with the installation.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMITS P.R.C. 2636.9 AND P.R.C. 2655.9 PROVIDING FOR THEIR EXTENSION TO SEPTEMBER 30, 1962. THE CONSIDERATION IS THE INTEREST OF NATIONAL DEFENSE.
