THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A TWO-YEAR RENEWAL OF LEASE P.R.C. 595.1 TO JOHN A. FITZGERALD AT A TOTAL RENTAL OF \$300. THE RENEWAL IS TO BE EFFECTIVE AS OF SEPTEMBER 30, 1961. THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF THE LEASE AREA IS AS FOLLOWS:

APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF LEASE P.R.C. 595.1, COVERING CERTAIN TIDE AND SUEMERGED LANDS OF MIDDLE RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, JOHN A. FITZGERALD - W.O. 4168.

John A. Fitzgerald, the lessee of a small parcel of tide and submerged lands in Middle River, adjacent to the Borden Highway Bridge, San Joaquin County, has applied for a two-year renewal of Lease P.R.C. 595.1. He has deposited \$300, being the total established rental for the period and representing an increase of \$100 over the previous two-year period.

By letter dated April 24, 1957, the attorneys for the owner of the upland advised that they have no objection to the continuance of the lease. The surety bond is still in effect.
