MINUTE ITEM

16. APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT; SAN LUIS OBISPO, SANTA BARBATA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY - W.O. 4181, P.R.C. 2823.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 28 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, IN CONFORMANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 1962, TO JUNE 30, 1962, INCLUSIVE, AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA:

- A. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY AND THE SEAVARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SEAVARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF X = 1,441,189.36 FEET AND Y = 335,615.67 FEET.
- B. LYING BETWEEN THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF X=1,515,471.78 FEST AND Y=338,667.70 FEST, AND A LINE FORMING THE NORTHWESTEPLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF.
- C. LYING BETWEEN THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL A AND THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF FARCEL B, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE MAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL.
- D. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAVARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.
- E. LYING BETWEEN THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B AND THE NORTH-WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL D, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA.

APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT; SAN LUIS OBISPO, SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY - W.O. 4181.

An application has been received from Signal Oil and Gas Company for a geological survey permit covering portions of the tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission in San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego Counties, for the six-month period commencing January 1, 1962.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, IN CONFORMANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 1962, TO JUNE 30, 1962, INCLUSIVE, AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA:

- A. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH LIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF X = 1,441,189.36 FEET AND Y = 335,615.67 FEET.
- B. LYING BETWEEN THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE GOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE SEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF X = 1,515,471.78 FREET AND Y = 338,667.70 FREET, AS A LINE FORMING THE NORTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH AND THE SEAVARD EXTENSION THEREOF.
- C. LYING BETWEEN THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL A AND THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL.
- D. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.
- E. LYING BETWEEN THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B AND THE NORTH-WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL D, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA.
